WORKPLACE SUPPORT

Employers should be able to provide a point of contact for the participant that will help answer any employment-related questions (ie. how do I clock in, where is the break room, when can I eat my lunch, etc.)

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Employers agree to pay participants to attend up to 48 hours of professional development classes provided by Work in Burke over the course of 90 days. Classes may be held twice a month and will include OSHA-10. CPR/First-aid, Business Ethics, Management Skills, and more.
